Arrive: Sunday 16th July 2023 (you can choose to arrive earlier)

Leave: Friday 21st July 2023 (you can choose to stay later)

Build Days: Monday 17th July to Thursday 20th July 2023

Build Times: Approx. 8.15 am to 5.30pm each day with an approx. 1pm finish Thursday

Airports: Denver International Airport (DEN) - 59 Minutes from Greeley, CO

Registration: The registration for attending the Big Balloon Build is \$374 for the 4 days of

the build. You will receive a special delegate T-Shirt as part of registration.

All registrants MUST plan to be at the Build site everyday from beginning to end be part of the evening social events, and food package. There are NO

registration only options.

Registration is NOT open to anyone living or working within 140 miles of Greeley, Colorado. This includes (but is not limited to) Castle Rock, Denver,

Cheyenne, Sterling, Colorado Springs.

Deposit: A \$99 nonrefundable payment is required to secure your place once your

application has been approved. This MUST be paid within 48 hrs. or your place is not fully offered until this payment is made. Please note, if you cancel your registration at any point after signing up, you will forfeit your \$99

deposit.

Hotel: Hotel options are listed below, although you can book and stay wherever you

want...we just suggest it's close to the Build site. It is your responsibility to book your stay. All Builders must arrive by no later than Sunday, July 16th. You are welcome to arrive earlier to check out the sights and participate in socials that will be arranged for Sunday afternoon as well as the Friday after

the Build.

Food:

31st March 2023 to 31st May 2023.

If you are unable to attend for any reason after 31st March 2023, including but not exclusive to medical issues, family emergencies, business decisions and the like, you will receive a refund on any food you have paid for, however at this stage your registration is non-refundable.

While we completely understand that you may have a very valid reason to cancel your registration, the Big Balloon Build is dependent upon the registration to cover the operating costs of the entire event.
